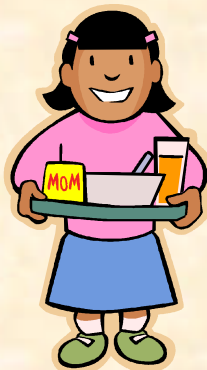

Would you be interested in a private school bus service for the Upper School morning and afternoon sessions?

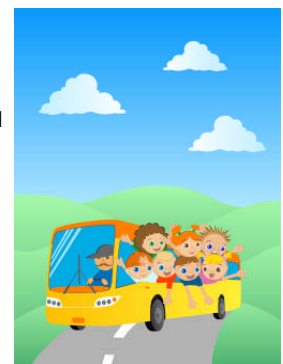
There is a possibility we may organise a route from the Marlow area through Bourne End and Cookham if we have enough interested parties.
